

Charlotte County Co-mingled Recycling

1. At this time, co-mingled recyclables are ONLY accepted at the Charlotte Court House Recycling Center.
2. Please only put "**Acceptable Items**" in your co-mingled bin. Unacceptable items may contaminate other recyclables and make them "**not recyclable.**"
3. **Use a clear or light colored trash bag to hold your co-mingled recyclables.**
4. **All Acceptable Items below can be "co-mingled" in one container!** There's no need to sort or separate. Everything will be separated at the processing facility.

Acceptable Items for Co-mingling



Newspaper

Includes Newspapers, inserts & advertisements



FLATTEN BOXES

Cardboard & Paperboard

Includes corrugated boxes & dry food boxes (like cereal & cracker boxes)



Magazines, Catalogs, Phone Books, & Soft Cover Books



NO SHREDDED PAPER

Mixed Paper

Includes Junk Mail, Computer Paper, etc.

Aluminum and Steel Cans

Plastic Bottles with or stamped on the bottom

Includes soda, shampoo & detergent bottles and milk, juice, & water jugs

Unacceptable Items

Placing unacceptable items in your co-mingled recycling can contaminate recyclable materials, making them unrecyclable. Some unacceptable items, such as plastic bags, can also damage processing equipment.

Aerosol cans

Aluminum foil or aluminum food containers

Aluminum siding

Food contaminated items (such as pizza boxes & food wrappers)

Glass - **Please separate glass & place in the glass collection bin at our recycling centers**

Hardcover books

Herbicide or pesticide containers

Motor oil containers

Napkins, paper towels & tissues

PLASTIC BAGS - **Please recycle bags at retailers such as Food Lion, Lowes & Kroger.**

Plastic coated paper

Plastic lids or caps - **Most are not made from #1 or #2 plastics**

Plastics other than #1 or #2

Scrap metal

Styrofoam

Wrapping paper

Waxed cardboard (such as milk cartons & juice boxes)
