

Charlotte County Planning Commission & Charlotte County Board of Supervisors
Joint Public Hearing
August 19, 2014

The Charlotte County Board of Supervisors and the Charlotte County Planning Commission held a joint public hearing at 7:00 pm on Tuesday, August 19th, 2014, in the board room of the Charlotte County Administration Office. The purpose of this hearing was to receive public comment regarding the County's proposed zoning and subdivision ordinances.

At 7:00 pm Nancy Carwile, Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, called the Board of Supervisor's public hearing to order.

Clark Poindexter, Chairman of the Planning Commission, called the Planning Commission's public hearing to order.

County Administrator Russell B. Clark read the accessibility statement and Clark Poindexter gave the invocation.

County Planner Monica Elder presented a brief history of the project. Ashley Cooper with Placeworks Collaborative and Milton Herd with Herd Planning and Design gave a project overview and reviewed proposed changes to the zoning and subdivision ordinances. Clark Poindexter provided comments from the Planning Commission.

There being no members of the public present, the Board of Supervisors and Planning Commissioners were called on for comments. Nancy Carwile relayed several comments she had received, noting that she had already responded to those comments.

There being no further questions or comments, the Board of Supervisors' public hearing and the Planning Commission's public hearing were adjourned.
