For the counties listed in the Heart of Virginia guide, it would mean a direct economic impact of \$48 million in new income each year. That is a small step we can all take to grow the local economy.

Please, take the challenge and pledge to spend \$10 a week on locally grown food. This guide will help you find exactly what you're looking for in the Heart of Virginia region!


