

MINUTES, CALLED MEETING OF THE CHARLOTTE COUNTY ELECTORAL BOARD

APRIL 23, 2020

The Chair called and convened a meeting of the Charlotte County Electoral Board for the purpose of dealing with an emergency re-location of the Bacon/Saxe precinct voting location from the Southall Community Building to Shiloh Baptist Church, 125 Shiloh Church Road, Drakes Branch, Virginia 23937. Present: Glenwood Foster, Chair; Lawrence Clark, Vice-Chair and Robert Bradner, Secretary.

The Chair called the meeting to order. Mr. Foster led the Board in the Pledge of Allegiance and prayer.

The Chair stated that the meeting was called for the purpose of submitting paperwork to have Bacon/Saxe precinct be relocated to Shiloh Baptist Church by emergency order as referenced in Section 24.2-310, Subsection D of the Virginia Code. The emergency action is taken because the Southall Community Building has on-going issues with its bathrooms, making them functionally unusable; there is no wired telephone connection to the building and cell service is spotty on all available carriers; handicap ramps are non-compliant (one has been granted a waiver); parking is inadequate and cars get stuck during rainy weather; discovery of a significant termite infestation; and, there is inadequate space for social distancing.


Shiloh Baptist Church has adequate space suitable for use as a polling place, has been visited by Board members, has the approval of the Registrar and is willing for its facility to be used as a polling place.

The Board expressed its gratitude to the membership of Shiloh Baptist Church and to its leadership for their cooperation, especially under emergency conditions necessitating emergency action to relocate the polling place prior to the June 2020 election.


