Chairman Carwile called the work session to order at 6:30 pm and turned the meeting over to Todd Fortune, Deputy Director of the Commonwealth Regional Council.

Mr. Fortune reviewed Chapters 1 & 2 of the draft comprehensive plan with the Commission and requested input on comments previously provided by staff. Commissioners and staff recommended several clarifications, expansions, and corrections to the two chapters.

Commissioners inquired about the inclusion of the Amish population in the demographic information. After additional discussion, Mr. Fortune recommended that he work with staff to come up with a plan to obtain additional data.

Commissioners requested expanded information on school population as well to include private school attendance and homeschool attendance if available.

Due to time constraints, discussion of the survey was postponed until the July work session.
