Garland Hamlett, Vice-Chairman of the Charlotte County Board of Supervisors, called the Board of Supervisors' public hearing to order at 7:00 pm.

Deborah Haskins, Chairman of the Planning Commission, called the Planning Commission hearing to order, stating that the purpose of the hearing was to receive public comment regarding a conditional use permit application for the construction of a U.S. Cellular tower on property owned by C.E. Overstreet, Jr., Brenda Overstreet & Ross Overstreet on property identified as Tax Parcel #33-A-41 and located on Barrett Road (Route 785) in Phenix.

County Planner Monica Elder provided a staff report on the application.
